Logistics Performance Index is an interactive benchmarking tool created to help countries identify the challenges and opportunities they face in their six (6) core performance components on trade logistics and what they can do to improve their overall performance:

- **▶**Customs
- Infrastructure
- ▶ International shipment
- Logistics quality and competence
- Tracking and tracing
- ▶ Timeliness.

■What's a Logistic Hub?

- □ The center of a specific area where all the activities relating to transport, logistics and goods distribution both for national and international transit are carried out on a commercial basis.
- Single and neutral legal body (preferably PPP)
- Support Import/export
- Road/rail/sea/air/inland port
- Compliant with free market rules, Performance & quality standards

Integrated Logistics – Special Economic / Bonded / Free Zones



□ Special Economic Zones / Free Zones

Industry cluster / innovation driven with specific incentive regime to attract investments e.g. JIZAN, OXAGON

Bonded Zones

It is the area under the supervision of the competent customs department and the management of the operating company of the bonded zone, in which the goods placed are suspended from duties and restrictions.

e.g. B2B postponement services, VAS, deferred taxes, (de)consolidation, B2C..
